39. Only 3,000 Pathfinders will be able to participate in the Community Service Day at the Camporee. The first 3,000 to sign up are those that will be able to participate. A letter will be coming to your individual clubs next spring regarding how to sign up. Projects will range from planting trees to painting houses, to a food drive to distributing literature.

40. Why is your \$95.00 not refundable?

- A. We are operating this Camporee at "cost" and this figure is what it will cost us per person.
- B. It helps us plan a budget.
- C. The Camporee is not subsidized by a Conference, Union, or the GC, as most Adventist functions are.
- D. We've learned from the '85 and '89 Camporees that lost many thousands of dollars.
- E. We are running this Camporee like a business.
- F. It is non-refundable because we are reserving you a space, whether you make it or not. If you don't come, we could have sold your ticket to someone else.

41. At the Camporee, there will be a table where all the accounting books are laid out and you can see how all monies were spent for this event. We will have someone staffing this table, so that any questions you have, can be answered.

42. The word is getting around!!! South Africa and Switzerland have requested information. Brochures have gone to Brazil and the Platas, from California, are taking more brochures down to South America!

43. If you are volunteering for the Camporee, your \$95.00 registration fee can be a tax deduction. We will mail you a receipt upon your request.

44. We are sorry, but NO PETS are allowed at the Camporee unless you have written permission. Call (303) 733-3771 for more information.

45. The Camporee will not be a major food supplier. Perishable items will be available on site, but Clubs will have to go off-site to do the majority of their grocery shopping. Your registration packets (they will come to you next Spring) will contain maps that will show you where supermarkets are, as well as bulk food suppliers (e.g. SAM'S or PACE).

46. The DARE TO CARE logo is a registered and copyrighted trademark. Your club may use the logo with written permission. Once you get permission, we will send you the "artwork" of the patch/logo. There is a quality standard for using the logo, so you will also need to "register" how you intend to use it. We also reserve the right to say "no" if a product is out of line.
