

1. Bible and a Buck: The "Bible and a Buck" Sabbath morning offering tradition began in 2004 at the Joseph, Faith on Fire International Camporee. The nighttime program director Rob Lang presented the idea to FOF Camporee leadership that, just like the ancient Egyptian's brought grain into the store house to feed their people during a famine; the Pathfinders should being to the International Camporee a "Bible



and a Buck" (\$1.00US is for shipping, storage, offering report & Pathfinders used for Bible distribution) to feed those around the world who do not have Bibles to feed their souls.



2. AWA: The pathfinder plane will be deployed in Uganda to provide aviation support to ADRA missionaries working there. The plane is currently due for its overhaul, which will include installing a diesel engine because diesel fuel is more readily available in Uganda. Other modifications will be made to equip the plane for the work that it will be doing

in country. The cost for the new engine, overhaul and modifications is estimated to be \$256,950.

3. Care for Cuba: The pathfinders in Cuba will also be receiving a portion of Sabbath's offerings. This money will go to backpacks for each pathfinder to use with information and kits to help them outreach to the people in their community. Additionally, each club will receive an iPad with valuable information and tools to direct their leaders in outreach and leading their youth.
